## **Health Guidance Procedure**

We may on occasion have to ask you to collect your child if we think that they are unwell. For some conditions we may require confirmation from a medical professional before the child can return. This is to help protect all children and staff.

Calpol will not be administered unless prescribed by a medical professional.

## Should I keep my child off nursery? Guidance taken from NHS website

Yes	Until
Diarrhoea and vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Cold and flu-like illness including Covid 19	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow national guidance if tested positive for Covid 19
Impetigo	sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after starting antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	had first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after starting antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after starting antibiotics
